EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- This report outlines the framework for measuring the success of the Race and Identity Based Data Strategy and providing an update on the work completed to date within the Use of Force priority area.
- The Hamilton Census Population and Arrest Apprehension Population will be used to calculate the legislative mandatory Disproportionality and Disparity Indices. The outcome of these calculations flag to the Hamilton Police Service the necessity for further investigations and are not endpoints, but invitations to raise questions and gather answers.
- Engagement with the Community Advisory Panel (CAP) has resulted in a set of
 prioritized, community-informed questions focused on racial and identity-based
 equity in use of force. Phase 1 of the RIBD Strategy will aim to answer these
 questions in consultation with the CAP and the broader community. Strong analytical
 methods will complement basic diagnostic tools to help identify the factors driving
 any findings of inequity, while accounting for situational variables such as subject
 behavior and the context of the interaction.
- All findings will be refined with input from the Community Advisory Panel and will undergo broader community consultation and action planning to address any identified inequities.
